I really hated it at school. I didn't want to go and I often came home from school crying.

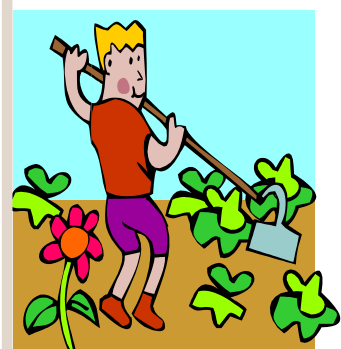
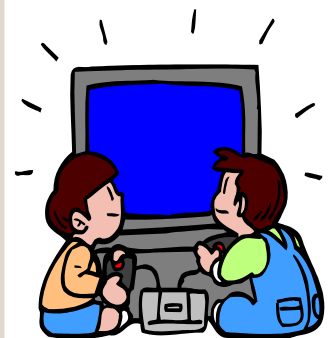
But at least now I am home Educated. It is the best thing Mummy has ever decided.
